What will I learn?

- How to identify and provide effective first aid for a number of different common childhood illnesses and injuries
- How to deal with unconscious casualties and administer CPR
- How to deal with selected first aid incidents such as:
 - Choking, bleeding, shock, poisoning and other minor injuries
- The roles and responsibilities of a paediatric first aider

Who is it for?

Anyone aged 19+; you may be entitled to a free course.

What do I need to bring with me?

Pen and notebook

Important Information about your Course:

- You are expected to attend every week/session
- If you are taking an exam this may be held on a different day and in a different location from where you have attended your course. An exam timetable will be given at the start of the course
- The course requires you to be physically able to perform certain techniques eg CPR and you will be required to kneel on the floor and perform chest compressions etc.
- Meets all the requirements of the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 and the Health and Safety Executive. Enabling staff to act as the nominated first aider in the paediatric workplace.
- Assessment activities will include demonstration and observation of practical activities and completion of some short written and multiple choice questions.
- You will need to provide proof of identity in the form of photographic ID at the first class. This could be a passport, photographic driving licence or work ID badge etc.
